All comments left on the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department (Department) social media pages are the sole responsibility of the commenter. Because these pages are public-facing, you participate at your own risk, taking personal responsibility for your comments, your username and any information provided. When you submit a comment on our pages you agree that the comment content is your own, and that the Department is harmless from any and all repercussions, damages, or liability.

All posted content must comply with the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department policy for posting. The Department reserves the right to

remove any post that does not comply with this policy. In addition, the Department also reserves the right to ban individuals who violate any of the guidelines listed below or Meta, Twitter, or Youtube's terms of service.



The Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department does not allow the following posts and content on our social media pages:

- Comments that are fraudulent or suggest or encourage illegal activity.
- Comments that promote, foster or perpetuate discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability or sexual orientation.
- Comments that defame, harass, abuse, stalk, threaten, or otherwise violate the legal rights of others.
- Graphic, obscene, abusive, hateful, or explicit comments or submissions; including acronyms or creative spellings of swear words or phrases, including using asterisks or spaces between words and letters.
- Comments or posts that disclose information which the agency and its employees are required to keep confidential by law.
- Uploaded or attached files that contain software or other material protected by intellectual property laws unless you own or control the rights thereto or have received all necessary consents. If there appear to be copyright issues, content may be removed.
