Alternative Toilet Guidance

The construction of a structure intended primarily to shelter and stabilize portable toilets for the convenience of the traveling public is not subject to the Wastewater System and Potable Water Supply Rules (Rules) under the following conditions:

- A. The structure is limited in size to what is needed to accommodate one or more portable toilets and/or associated portable hand washing units and the floor space needed to access to these facilities. The structure may include space for vending machines described in section C below. The structure may include a floor, a roof, and up to 75% of the perimeter may be enclosed.
- B. There shall be no employees stationed at these structures.
- C. No food or beverages may be sold or served at these structures other than vending machine type food and beverages that is pre-packaged and dispensed as a serving for an individual. These machines may be located within the structure housing the portable toilets and/or portable handwashing facilities.
- D. The portable toilets/hand washing units shall not serve as the toilet/hand washing facilities for any other building or structure unless the use of that other building/structure qualifies for such facilities under another provision of the alternative toilet guidance document.
- E. Any variation from the above described operation may cause the project to become subject to the Rules, in which case the landowner is responsible for obtaining the required permit under the Rules.
