This funding will ensure Vermonters have safe, reliable drinking water and adequate wastewater disposal. The funding process involves multiple steps:

The ANR Healthy Homes Program selects priority projects and contacts the applicants with next steps.

Submitting Applications

The ANR Healthy Homes Program invites applicants with prioritized projects to submit an application to confirm their eligibility. The Program reviews the information reported on the applications through tax documents, signed forms, and site visits.

The ANR Healthy Homes Program issues awards to applicants once their applications have been verified.





Awardees hire a contractor of their choice to complete the project and the State issues payment for the work.
