Product Registration

Products are classified as A, B, C.
Several hundred new products added
annually. Others discontinued—
usually 2 years req'd



2017 approximate products
registered (10K):

A: 1200 (300 fed/900 st)

B: 2500

C: 6300

Product Use

Annual submission of use data is required for commercial companies and non-commercial/government entities at license renewal.

Paper-based; in 2 years, possible on-line renewal.

Entered into a database by a program administrative assistant.

Data transferred in 2009 from a UNIX-system to a 3rd party vendor product. Issues related to that transfer exist.

Required to post annual use summary – current issues, general trend information.

Private Applicators do not report use, but have certain record-keeping requirements.

Product Sales & Distribution

Licensed Class A Dealers report annual sales & storage of restricted use products

Class B and C Dealers—the majority of products *registered* in state— do not track sales.

Out-of-state (certified) salespersons submit annual sales report.

Entered into same 3rd party database as use data.

The internet????

Production Facilities

EPA (Region 1) has oversight of pesticide production facilities.

Agriculture has one (1) employee with federal credentials to inspect facilities.

Currently very few in state (less than 20)

Pesticide Producing Establishments must report annually to the EPA using EPA software or paper.

Resources available

Less than 0.5 FTE through the year

- Licensing & registration centralized,
- Staff dedicated to pesticides October-December.

Field agents

- Help when able
- Focus on use, retail inspections & training

Software

- Historical issue
- Technical knowledge
