**1. Welcome and Agenda review**

**2. Overview of December report requirements – EO Section III.B.**

The Committee discussed how to approach each of the 4 items within this section:

- B.(1) and (2): A sub-group including Schwer, Herrick, Vose, and Meyer will use the Tier II database to look at items (1) and (2). The Act 154 Report may also be used to help provide the information called for in these items.
- B.(3): Gonda will look at this item. Walke also requested other Committee members look at it as well and provide her with any changes to their respective statutes and rules.
- B.(4): Walke requested the Committee members talk with their respective teams about this item and report back at the Committee’s September meeting with thoughts and ideas. Giguere and Kamman will look at the terms “regulated” and “unregulated” in this item to develop working definitions for the Committee.

The Committee will discuss the results of these tasks at the September meeting, with another meeting scheduled in September to conduct a more in-depth discussion. The CAP will be invited to a meeting in November to provide feedback on draft findings in advance of the December 15 report deadline.

**3. Discussion of Executive Order Task 3 (EO Section III.A.(3)) and Next Steps**

Walke and Vose will take the feedback provided by the CAP on the Task 3 Report recommendations to further advance those recommendations. This would include developing definitions and more specific criteria for the process. Others will be pulled in as needed. Their initial findings will be provided at the September meeting.

**4. Agency/Department updates**

Department of Health has updated its health advisory limit on PFAS. ANR is initiating rulemaking to put the health advisory limit into its Groundwater Protection Rule and then the IRule.
