WHAT WE DO:

State Surplus Program

The Surplus Property Program provides various mechanisms for the disposition of state surplus materials and equipment. These are items that are no longer needed by the state agency department that purchased it. Items may be purchased through our showroom in Waterbury, offered for bid, or available through online public auctions and physical public auctions.

The Surplus Property showroom is located at 434 US Route 2 in Waterbury. Our warehouse is open for sales to state agencies and departments and the public from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Monday – Friday and 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays. The warehouse is closed for all [State Holidays](#).

E-Cycling

Surplus property is an [e-cycling](#) collection center. [Vermont's E-Cycles statute](#) provides for free and convenient collection of computers, monitors, printers, computer peripherals, and televisions for covered entities.

Consumers, charities, school districts, and small businesses that employ 10 or fewer individuals can use the E-Cycles program for free. Other individuals who bring in seven (7) or fewer devices can also recycle at no charge. E-cycling rates for non-covered entities/items is 50 cents per pound.

Federal Surplus Program

The Federal Surplus Program aids in the acquisition and distribution of surplus property from various military and federal sources to qualifying public entities (towns, schools, districts, volunteer fire departments, etc) and non-profit organizations conducting educational and health care programs. This property is not available to the general public.

E-mail bgs.surplusproperty@vermont.gov to get set up with an application, User ID, and Password so that you can search the US General Services Administration GSAXcess system. Include the following information.

This system provides a listing of Federal surplus property that is available for transfer to eligible donees. You simply add the items you would like to your cart and check out to forward your request on to us. We will submit your request and notify you to coordinate pick-up if the item gets awarded to you.

Compliance Requirements on the majority of acquisitions: 18 months in use before you are able to trade or sell without restrictions.
